Dear Christian Friends:

This past month was one of the most exciting times in Bali. Our pastor, Mike Frazier, and Dave Livengood from Canton Baptist Temple, Canton, Ohio arrived on May 19 for the dedication of our new church building. But before their arrival we had to get everything ready for the big day. We installed a large water tank to increase water usage and we put night lights up around the property for security and also to accommodate the outside meal for our dedication. Small stones were brought in to cover part of our parking lot. We put up signs, banners, and had programs printed. We made hotel reservations for our pastor and guests from Jakarta, planned meals, and rented two cars for transporting the guests from the airport three hours away. The excitement was growing because we expected a full house.

When Pastor Frazier and Bro. Livengood arrived, we took them on a little tour before leaving for Singaraja. We wanted them to see as much of Bali as possible and to see the spiritual darkness of that Island. We took them to a monkey forest where over 500 monkeys live and are considered sacred as they roam inside and outside of the Hindu temple. They saw the active volcanos and wall-to-wall people and the effects of Hinduism as we drove through one village after another. It was a wonderful blessing to LaMoin and me and also to the church to have them present and to hear Bro. Frazier preach in our new building. We were blessed with an attendance of 85 for the dedication. Three days before the service, LaMoin and Eny (pastor's wife) had the thrill of leading a lady to the Lord Jesus Christ.

Now our minds are focused on getting the next stage of the building completed - a place for Pastor Wayan and Eny to live and to start the orphanage. It is absolutely essential that he lives on the property to protect the church against thieves. At present, he or his 84 year old father sleep in the shell of the demolished house at the back to protect the church. It will cost about \$10,000 to totally complete the project. Please pray with us for God to provide this important need.

Pray that we are able to keep getting new folks into our new building so they can hear the gospel. The law prohibits door-to-door and street witnessing but when they come into our building we can tell them the gospel. We are praying for money to install wall unit air conditioners which will encourage people to come when the temperature and humidity are close to 100 degrees.

Thank you for your continued support and prayers. With your help, this work can go forward.
