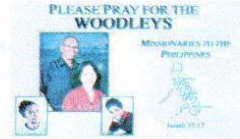




# The Woodley Family Missionaries to the Philippines

Dear Pastor and Praying Friends,

Several years ago, we pictured ourselves starting as a struggling congregation where none existed before, and seeing it mature gradually into an independent local church reaching the community of both hearing and deaf with Calvary's love. It is amazing to watch how a little church grow, becoming the first link in our community to spread the Gospel of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. In this, God used us in a small way to keep His promise in Matthew 16:18, "And I say unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it." The Lord's work in Bamban, Philippines continues to grow as we have witnessed this summer.

First was a week of Vacation Bible School (VBS) held last May. Fifty five children aged three to 12 came to participate in this event. Our theme for the week was, "Creation." Each day was spent with storytelling, crafts work, games and snacks. At the end of the week, 21 children professed Christ as Savior.

Second was the Young People's camp at Mt. Peniel, which is several kilometers north of Bamban. It is a Christian prayer sanctuary seated at the top of a hill adjacent to former American facility named, Camp O'Donnell. Our young people had a wonderful time of devotion, prayer and soul searching. It is always a blessing to see young people give their lives to the Lord.

Third was the celebration of our Deaf Church Anniversary last May. We celebrated this eventful moment with Evangelist Ronnie Rice of the Bill Rice Ranch in Murfreesboro, Tennessee. Bro. Rice preached for us and we were all blessed to share this wonderful time with 167 individual members of both hearing and deaf and guests. It was also a blessing to have Bob and Brenda Himes come to celebrate with us. They have been working with the Deaf for over 30 years.

Fourth and not least, we praise the Lord for the salvation of Ana and Glenda Luz who came from the Bicol region which is some 18 hours travel down south of Luzon from our place. The Luzes were the relatives of our dearly beloved Jeaneth Luz, a deaf teacher. It brought tears of joy in Jeaneth's heart to see her mother and sister come to the saving knowledge of Christ. We therefore covet your prayers for the Luzes and also for Victoria Pili and Haidy Diane Amurao. The two followed the Lord in believer's baptism that same month of June.

We praise the Lord for the benefit of knowing that Christ may come and rapture us out of this old sinful world at anytime. Please continue to pray for my wife Carol as she administers our deaf school here. We also covet your prayers for our sons Christopher and Emmanuel who are in college in America. From the bottom of our hearts, thank you for your prayers and sacrificial giving to our ministry here in the Philippines. May God bless you.
